



The **overall project goal** is to unleash the innovation potential of **Alpine natural resources**, translating them into concrete tools and strategies to ensure continued opportunities for livelihood in peripheral regions in the Alps.

Through a multilevel-stakeholder approach **4 outputs** are developed, with the aim to **develop health tourism** and position the **Alpine Space** as an **attractive healing region** for civilization diseases.



11 partners from all over the **Alpine arc** cooperate in a unique network incorporating NGOs, universities, protected areas, public institutions and private companies, with the common goal of combining knowledge by researchers and experts from the private and public sectors, with the practical approach and networking power of local public organisations and Alpine associations.
