To increase understanding of the circular economy, visitors to the Info Day were also able to take an online survey on Monitoring and Understanding the Circular Economy, which they took first before we said anything about the project itself, the circular economy and the Norwegian Financial Mechanism. Later, they took a survey on how we explained their understanding of the circular economy, re-use, etc.

We decided to do online surveys to reduce our ecological footprint. This is because such a survey does not produce waste materials such as used paper questionnaires or cardboard boxes to store them. This reduces the amount of waste generated during the survey. An online survey also eliminates the need to print paper questionnaires, which reduces paper consumption.
